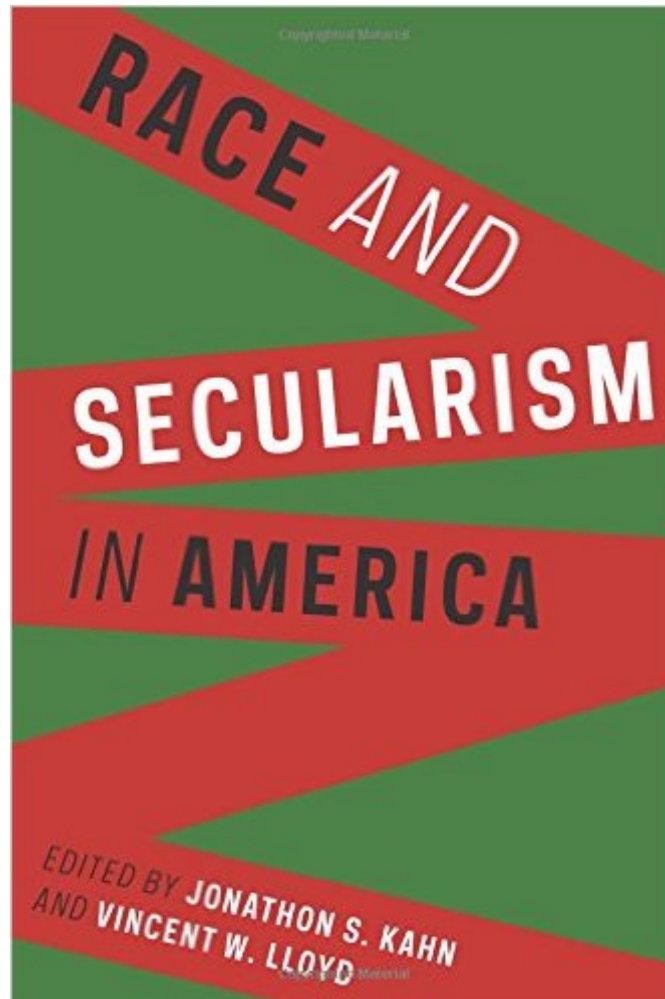


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Race And Secularism In America (Religion, Culture, And Public Life)
